- The Principal reviewed and invited modifications/suggestions to the AQAR dated 15 March 2017.
- 2. IQAC chair and members commented and gave their input on the same.
- The chair presented a progress report/non-conformances listed as goals in the previous report are almost accomplished during the current year.
- 4. The coordinator listed the significant activities and initiatives taken by the IQAC during the year as under:

- 6. The Chair informed that the SPIPA DTC project has been under revision by the authorities and due reminders have been sent as well as compliance report and audit reports also have been sent for the previous batches. The chair hoped that it will soon be revived.
- 7. It was proposed further that by the time this program is revived, the college can start its own career guidance classes for competitive examinations on the lines of SPIPA DTC model. All the members greeted this thought with enthusiasm.

- 8. The Chair shared that multimedia classrooms are now equipped with amplifier system.
- It was further shared that CHE had recently called a meeting at Gandhinagar for classroom reforms and significant amount of learning aid is granted to Lalan College.
 This granted aids includes 5 Smart Board Projection System.
- 10. It was shared that this granted aids will further add to the College's existing learning infrastructure.
- 11. New faculty involved in curriculum restructuring/revision/syllabus development as member of Board of Study/Faculty/Curriculum Development workshop were greeted by the committee.
- 12. Student feedback mechanism was analyzed department-wise and innovations such as online forms were suggested.
- 13. It was stated that in terms of initiatives of the IQAC in Sensitizing/Promoting Research Climate in the institution, the committee has been providing encouragement for research and publications and has been helping in preparing major and minor research proposals.
- 14. The members expressed that UGC has not declared results for pending applications for Major/Minor projects.
- 15. The meeting concluded with the plan of action for the next year. The goals set for the next year are as follows:

 - Following up on the proposed extension plan of the college building
 - Proposing new building for Boys' Hostel in the campus
