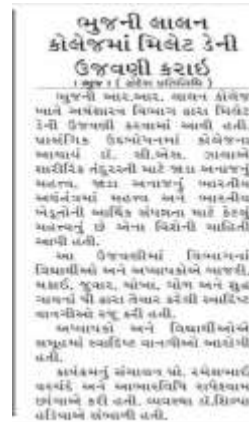


Celebration of Milletus Day
